	Read the Prescribing Information document Read the Pharmacy Agreement Form(s) from the appropriate manufacturer(s) Be able to receive Prescriber Agreement Forms via fax and email Be able to use a shipping service that provides tracking information (if planning to ship or mail mifepristone) Designate an authorized representative to carry out certification process on behalf of the pharmacy Ensure that the authorized representative oversees the implementation and compliance of the Mifepristone REMS Program as outlined in the Pharmacy Agreement Forms Sign the Pharmacy Agreement Form(s) and fax or submit electronically to the appropriate manufacturer(s) Ensure you have completed everything on the mifepristone dispensing checklist, EVERY time you dispense a prescription for mifepristone Comply with audits carried out by the Mifepristone Sponsors or by a third party acting on their behalf to ensure that all processes and procedures are in place and being followed
