APPLICATION GUIDE

California independent pharmacies currently serving Medi-Cal patients:
Follow these steps to earn a \$2,000 grant for your pharmacy!

Apply for the Grant

Complete the [Pharmacists CARE Application](#) to enroll

Complete Required Training

Have at least one pharmacist complete the [Medication Abortion Care at the Pharmacy](#) course (1 hour ACPE-accredited, online, on-demand)

Submit Pharmacy Agreement Form

Choose either to submit the [Danco Agreement](#) or [Genbiopro Agreement](#)

Set up Your Ordering Account

Once you are approved, create ordering accounts:

- [Cencora](#) (for Danco - Mifeprex®)
- [R&S Northeast](#) (for GenBioPro - generic mifepristone 200 mg)

Order your Medication

Order mifepristone and misoprostol and submit your invoice as proof of having the medication in stock.

Prepare Your Pharmacy

Review the [Implementation Toolkit](#) to get ready to dispense.

Submit your W-9

Complete and submit the [Federal W-9 Form](#) for the current fiscal year to receive payment.



Receive your \$2,000 grant!

FAQs

Can multi-location pharmacies apply?

Yes, each location applies as a separate site, and each site should have a trained pharmacist and its own documentation.

Who should the W-9 be made out to (legal entity name vs. DBA)?

Use the legal business name that matches your IRS/tax records. If you use a DBA, list it on the “Business name/DBA” line, but the primary name should be the legal/tax entity name.
